

## FBWRA Chairman's Report for May 2021 Committee Meeting

Chaville Court- update from Thames Water received – they are working with Network Rail on the safety case to allow access to railway land for works

FORAB – As previously reported, I have asked FORAB's Chairman if we can post FORAB minutes on our website. Response still awaited. Reminder sent.

Highways, etc Sub- Committee – preliminary meeting later this month subject to arrangements.

Potential Committee recruit - Following discussion I have suggested this lady might like to come to our June meeting, and I have given her details of Council democracy website to explore

### Planning -

North Finchley Town Centre Regeneration – result of FoI request review awaited. Although I understand the Chairman of the Board is to be Cllr Sarah Wardle (Con., Edgware)

Guidance for planning officers – in response to a FoI request, I am told that there are no internal documents giving guidance to officers on the implementation of planning policies, just the policy documents (Local Plan, etc) themselves.

Council Tax Records and Planning Enforcement – response to FoI request indicates tax records not used for planning enforcement ( why not?)

Parking Surveys for planning applications- As previously reported , FoI request essentially rejected. I appealed to the Council's in-house review system. Result received- partly upheld but no useful information provided. I have reformulated the request and re-submitted it- response awaited

Application 20/5477/FUL 79 Chandos Avenue N20 9EG – Objection submitted

Application 21/1354/FUL Former 16 Church Way London N20 0LA – Objection submitted

Council – advertising on banners on lamp standards – objection submitted to Council for Whetstone application. No decision on application so far- “pending consideration”

CPZ's and ULEZ – I requested Cllr Geoff Cooke to assist on this – no response. I have also sent a FoI request to TfL.

Traffic signage at Mayfield Avenue, N12 – I have written to the Council questioning whether the current signage (access only) is lawful
