Data Protection- The information you provide in the form above is provided by you on a voluntary basis and will be used by FBWRA on the basis of our legitimate interests- maintaining our membership records, to assist in distributing our Newsletter, to communicate with you and in connection with our activities as a residents' association, including where we work with other organisations (for example, where we work with them on an issue of mutual interest). We may retain the information for up to six years after you cease to be a member. If you do not provide the information this may adversely affect our ability to carry out the purposes for which we intend to use the information.

You have the following rights under data protection legislation: to access a copy of the information comprised in your personal data; to object to use of your personal data that is likely to cause or is causing damage or distress; to prevent use for direct marketing; to object to decisions being taken by automated means (this is not done by FBWRA); in certain circumstances, to have inaccurate personal data rectified, blocked, erased or destroyed, and to claim compensation for damages caused by a breach of data protection legislation. If you have any concerns or complaints in relation to how FBWRA collects and/or uses your personal data, you should contact the Treasurer in the first instance. If you are dissatisfied with how your concern/complaint is dealt with by FBWRA, you have the right to report your concern/complaint to the Information Commissioner's Office (www.ico.org.uk).
