

FBWRA Chairman's Report for October 2022 Committee Meeting for website

Planning – NTR

Highways- Zebra crossings – update from member awaited.

- Traffic accidents – Longmore Avenue. I am troubled that such accidents occur in suburban streets. To be discussed. However, by way of context, the Borough's record in terms of numbers of serious accidents seems quite good – about 30% fewer accidents per 1000 population than in Enfield, for example.

FOI requests. Clarifications on three requests still awaited.- I assume they have been overlooked. As they were peripheral I do not intend to pursue further. A request for information about the reasons for selecting part of Parkway for resurfacing rather than other roads was refused on the ground it would be too expensive to answer.

Website- As previously reported , there is an issue with renewing our "security certificate". I have not had the opportunity of pursuing this.

Chaville Court- not yet resolved. Further works in hand as reported

Councillors meeting – Cllr Houston .Reply still awaited. His issues on planning matters may explain. I will raise again with him and also with Cllr Longstaff as discussed at the September meeting

FBWRA boundaries. I attach a copy of a map showing the Friern Barnet UDC boundaries in purple. This is our core area, although I don't think we have members south of the NCR. Our constitution allows us to accept members from elsewhere and we do this quite regularly.
