

FBWRA Chairman's Report for September 2022 Committee Meeting for website

Planning – appeals have been submitted against the two refusals for the telecoms mast in Friern Barnet Road

22/3307/FUL - 13 Friary Road N12 9RD - application to convert into 2 flats. Objection submitted. The Finchley Society have also objected. The application was withdrawn late in August

Highways- I have had discussions with a member concerning the Boroughs zebra crossings. He has now made FOI requests to Barnet and three other boroughs to obtain comparative data on modernisation of crossings. Update awaited

FOI requests. Clarifications on three requests still awaited.

CPZ results showed nothing useful

WFH response has been used as the material for an article in the August Newsletter

Website- As previously reported , I have looked at creating a "FixMyStreet" page but wish to discuss this with the Committee before proceeding further.

Recruitment leaflet. Draft awaited from YR

Chaville Court- not yet resolved.

North Finchley town centre redevelopment- I have finally been able to obtain confirmation (from Cllr Ross Houston) that the controversial land sale and site assembly agreements were signed before the May Council elections

Association PA system- I have discovered that this can run all four of our microphones simultaneously (rather than just two), which will assist with meetings.
