- Highways proposals and congestion

We publish a quarterly Newsletter which is delivered to all members (by email if preferred) and when appropriate hold meetings on relevant issues open to all members.

Issues that we have covered include:

- Council plans to sell the arts depot and car parks in North Finchley
- Traffic congestion in Friern Barnet
- Council policy on working from home
- Pinkham Way waste proposals
- Advertising banners in Whetstone
- Local flooding
